To Whom it may concern,

My name is Rita M. St. Onge and on 7-25 -07 I arrived at 154 Howe St. around 2:00 P.M. to find a man fixing the front steps at 154 Howe St. Marlboro, Ma. I said "Hello" to him as I walked toward him and he snapped at me "who are you"? Can I help you?" I told him who I was and he told me attorney Crowley hired him to do repairs to this estate. I told him somebody had to get hurt to get anything done. I asked if he was going to fix the door which came off the hinges and hurt a tenant? His reply was "yes. He also said he was going to change the door that was broke, cut grass, fix gutters, on other house. He's got a list he made up days ago. Asked about securing my Aunts house finally (Annette's house) He said "yes I have to talk to Mr. Crowley about changing locks at 141 Howe St. He told me Attorney Crowley mentioned that he'd have to drill out locks and replace them. He will be calling Mr. Crowley after he finishes the door on his way home from work. I told him I was glad someone was going to finally secure my Aunts house since the thieves have already moved in and stole any thing of value. He asked me about stuff he needs to remove from 1<sup>st</sup> floor and cellar at 158 Howe St. I told him I know nothing about that. When I asked what was wrong with gutters, he walked me over to 158 Howe St. and I noticed the front storm door was gone. When I noticed that, I questioned him. He told me he removed it a few days earlier it was all kicked in and broke. I told him he was replacing the wrong door and showed him the plastic covered storm door on 154 Howe St. He told me they both needed to be replaced and will measure 154 Howe St. door today so he can get one. In the course of the day he repaired the front steps at 154 Howe St., repaired the front door on 154 Howe St. by using longer screws rather than replace the door, and replaced the front door at 158 Howe St. When he was leaving he reassured me he was calling Attorney Crowley so he could change the locks on 141 Howe Street finally securing my Aunt Annette Villeneuve's House.

Well he returned the next day 7-26-07 Thursdays. 9:45am RAD Enterprise). Measured the door at 154 Howe Street 1<sup>st</sup> floor then left. Returned in afternoon finished 158 Howe St. door, hung the storm door on 154 Howe Street. Pulled off board on back door of 154 Howe St. cleaned behind it then re-screwed it then silicone open crack and screw heads. Asked why silicone large crack instead of replacing board since he had it off, His reply was he was told to do repairs the cheapest way possible and that Attorney Crowley got appointed to this estate and has no time to be here so he was to do the work safest and cheapest way possible. Asked him if Attorney. Crowley has checked anything out that he said needed to be done? His reply was "Attorney Crowley got this dumped on him by the courts and really has no time for it. Asked about securing my Aunts house and he told me that Attorney Crowley told him to stay away from Eugene Villeneuve's house. It now belongs to Eugene Villeneuve - "It has nothing to do with the estate". I explained to him how the granddaughter threw me out of my Aunt's house on January 9, 2007. I was living there and taking care of my aunt Annette Villeneuve and Eugene Villeneuve for the last five years. Annette Villeneuve's granddaughter, Pamela Constanzo made a cell phone call and told me she was "Custodian of the Properties" and then had her husband change the locks, even though she was to get nothing from my Aunt's estate. He said "It's not right what happens to people estates when they die but as far as Mr. Crowley is concerned Eugene Villeneuve has the house now that his mother passed away and there's

no judge that will make him move. As far as Attorney Crowley is concerned he owns it now, it's all Eugene Villeneuve's responsibility to cut grass and maintain the property. As we were talking I noticed the storm door he replaced on 154 Howe St. had a 2 inch opening along the bottom.

I mentioned it to him. (The reason I do not know the mans name is because when I asked I was told RAB ENTERPRISE PROPERTY MAINTANACE and that's all.) He told me he could lower the door some but the kick plate wasn't long enough. He'd fix it later. I told him, now the bugs and snow would get in if it don't cover from top to bottom. He said "don't worry I'll fix it later. It's ok for now. Well as of today it still has an inch opening under door.

On 8-5-07 Sunday we noticed in the cellar of 154 Howe street the heater air ducts for the furnace were covered with black plastic material held up by thin wire and duct tape to metal hot air pipes. Pictures taken on all accounts.

Please your honor appoint an executor who cares about what my aunt wanted.


